Section 1. That the City of Concordia, Kansas shall accept the Grant Offer from the Administrator of Civil Aeronautics dated Feb. 24, 1948, for the purpose of obtaining Federal aid in the development of the Concordia Municipal Airport and that such Grant Offer shall be as set forth hereinbelow:

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Grant Offer agreement in sextuplet on behalf of the City of Concordia, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to impress thereon the official seal of the City of Concordia, Kansas, and to attest said execution.

Section 3. That the Grant Offer referred to hereinabove shall be as follows:

WHEREAS, The Sponsor has submitted to the Administrator a Project Application dated December 22, 1947 for a grant of Federal Funds for a project for the development of a class III airport (hereinafter referred to as the "Project") in accordance with the National Airport Plan formulated by the Administrator, which Project is described as follows:

Name of Airport Concordia Municipal Airport

Located at Concordia, Kansas

Project No. 9-14-007-701

Scope and description of development: Grading, drainage and turbing of N/S, NW/SE, and NE/SW landing strips, intermediate and building areas; furnishings and installing fencing, boundary markers, and segmented circle marker system:

and has also submitted to the Administrator a Sponsor's Assurance Agreement adopted by the Sponsor under date of December 9, 1947, relating to the operation and maintenance of said airport; which Project Application and Sponsor's Assurance Agreement are hereby specifically incorporated herein and made a part hereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to and for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of the Federal Airport Act (60 Stat. 170; Pub. Law 377, 79th Congress); and in reliance upon the representation made in said Project Application and Sponsor's Assurance Agreement; and in consideration of (a) the Sponsor's acceptance of this offer, as herein after provided, and (b) the benefits to accrue to the United States and the public from the accomplishment of the Project and the operation and maintenance of the airport,

THE ADMINISTRATOR, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED STATES, HEREBY OFFERS AND AGREES to pay, as the United States' share of costs incurred in accomplishing the project, 50 percentum of all allowable project costs, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The maximum obligation of the United States payable under this offer shall be \$44,467.00.
2. The sponsor shall
 - (a) begin accomplishment of the Project within a reasonable time after acceptance of this offer, and
 - (b) carry out and complete the Project in accordance with the terms of this offer and the Federal Airport Act and the Regulations promulgated thereunder by the Administrator on January 9, 1947, as amended, which Act and Regulations are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, and
 - (c) Carry out and complete the Project in accordance with plans and specifications (including revisions or modifications thereof), as approved by the Administrator or his duly authorized representative.
3. Any misrepresentation or omission of a material fact by the Sponsor concerning the Project or the Sponsor's Authority or ability to carry out the obligations assumed by the Sponsor in accepting this offer shall terminate the obligation of the United States, and it is understood and agreed by the Sponsor in accepting this offer that if a material fact has been misrepresented or omitted by the sponsor the Administrator on behalf of the United States may recover all grant payments made

6. It is hereby further understood and agreed by the parties hereto that all grant payments made under the Grant Agreement shall be made on a monthly basis.

Acceptance of this offer shall be evidenced by execution of this instrument by the Sponsor, as hereinafter provided, and said offer when so accepted shall comprise a Grant Agreement constituting the obligations and rights of the United States and the Sponsor with respect to the accomplishment of the Project and the operation and maintenance of the Concordia Municipal Airport.

It is hereby further agreed that the words "he" or "him" wherever used herein as referring to the Contractor shall be deemed to refer to said Contractor, whether a corporation, partnership of individual, and this contract and all covenants and agreements thereof shall be binding upon and for the benefit of the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of said Contractor.

It is hereby further agreed that any reference herein to the "Contract" shall include all "Contract Documents" as the same are listed and described in Paragraph II of Special Provisions dated December 1, 1947, issued in connection with the City of Concordia, Kansas, Concordia Municipal Airport Project No. 9-14-007-701, and said "Contract Documents" are hereby made a part of this agreement as fully as if set out at length herein.
