In order to qualify for a general contractor license, an applicant contractor shall designate a qualified individual who is both associated with the applicant as an owner, officer, director, or employee and active in the building decisions of the building contractor. General contractor licenses are issued to a business having at least one, but not more than two qualified individuals. An individual person may not be listed as the qualified individual for more than one general contractor license.

The qualified individual for a class A, B or C license is required to complete 12 hours of continuing education courses related to the building trades within the licensing period to renewal, currently 2 years.
