The basic qualifications for Corrections Officer are:

- Minimum 18 years of age with a high school diploma or GED.
- You must be in good health, pass a physical examination and agility test as prescribed by the department.
- Ability to understand and carry out orders, maintain discipline and orderly conduct.
- Ability to remain open minded, yet firm and calm under stressful conditions.
- Ability to safeguard confidential or classified information.

Job Objective: To maintain security, custody and care of residents of the Cumberland County Jail pending arraignment, release or after sentencing. To supervise residents in their personal and quarters cleanliness according to established rules and regulations.

The successful candidate must successfully pass a polygraph examination and a background check.
