Election Positions

Election Inspector: Works at ward tables. Verifies identification, has voter sign poll book and issues ballots. Limited use of technology needed.

Voter Registration: Assists voters to register, verifying ward and polling location on the computer. Some use of technology needed.

Ballot Counter: Oversees voters feeding their ballot into the tabulator and confirms ballot was counted. Hands out "I voted" stickers. Limited use of technology needed.

Special Voting Deputy: Assists Deputy Clerk with administering absentee voting at nursing homes/skilled nursing facilities in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes. Typically conducted 3 weeks prior to each election.

Chief Election Inspector: Manages the polling location on election day. Officially opens and closes the polls. Answers questions and assists other staff. Addresses citizen concerns/complaints. Helps with setting up and taking down of polling location. Works closely with Clerk to ensure smooth operations on Election Day. Additional training is required.
