

OAKLAND TOWNSHIP PARKS AND RECREATION COVID-19 SCREENING PROCEDURE (5-28-2021)

All Oakland Township Parks and Recreation (OTPR) Employees, Contractors, Visitors, Volunteers and Program Participants/Spectators will be required to perform COVID-19 Self-Screening upon arrival at OTPR Offices or OTPR-sponsored Programs. Please maintain social distance while waiting to perform self-screening.

This practice is to ensure the health and safety of our workforce and our visitors. Screenings will include a series of questions along with a temperature check prior to the start of each shift for OTPR employees or prior to start of an OTPR sponsored program.

SELF-SCREENING CHECKLIST TO FOLLOW

1. Unless fully vaccinated, please wear a facial mask during the screening process.
2. Use disinfecting hand wipes to clean the touchless thermometer before and after use and use hand sanitizer to clean hands before and after using the thermometer.
3. Use thermometer to take your own temperature (unless you are a minor who needs the assistance of an adult).
4. Consider questions below, and use sanitized pen to record your information on sign-in sheet. Screening Questions to Consider:
 - Do you have any of the following symptoms:
 - Temperature of 99.5 F or above?
 - Cough, fever, chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, muscle pain, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea?
 - Have you traveled to areas of the world that have widespread ongoing transmission of COVID-19, as identified by the CDC, or have you returned from a cruise ship or river cruise voyage in the last 14 days?
 - Have you had close contact with a confirmed/probable COVID-19 case?

If you answer NO to all questions, you have passed the screening and can begin working, enter the building, or attend the program.

If you answer YES to any of the questions, DO NOT begin working, DO NOT enter the building, DO NOT attend the program.

- If you are an OTPR employee or volunteer, contact the Safety Coordinator and leave the premises.
- If you are a program participant or spectator, leave the premises immediately and notify the Safety Coordinator.
