

ORDINANCE NO. 85-2019

INTRODUCED BY: COUNCIL MEMBERS MUNTEANU AND JONES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1240.09(a)(3)(A) OF THE OLMSTED FALLS CODIFIED ORDINANCES ENTITLED “ACCESSORY USE REGULATIONS” AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Olmsted Falls Codified Ordinance Section 1240.09(a)(3)(A) currently establish regulations regarding Accessory Use Regulations; and

WHEREAS, City Council and the Administration have reviewed said regulations and recommend updates in order to better facilitate the size of accessory buildings. Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That Olmsted Falls Codified Ordinance Section 1426.03, is hereby amended to read as follows: (new material appears like **THIS** and deleted material appears like ~~this~~)

1240.09 ACCESSORY USE REGULATIONS.

Accessory uses, buildings, and structures permitted in association with residential uses shall conform to the location, coverage, and maintenance standards contained in this section. Attached garages as part of a dwelling are subject to all yard requirements for a principal building specified in Sections 1240.05 or 1240.06 respectively.

(a) Area and Yard Requirements for Accessory Uses on Single-Family Lots.

(3) Garages and detached accessory building regulations. The number and size of accessory buildings and garages shall comply with the following:

A. Each dwelling unit shall have a two-car garage with a minimum floor area of 396 square feet. The garage may be either attached to or detached from the dwelling unit. The maximum floor area of a garage shall be ~~600 880~~ square feet **ON ANY LOT LESS THAN ONE ACRE, AND 880 SQUARE FEET FOR** an attached or detached garage **ON ANY LOT GREATER THAN ONE ACRE.** A dwelling unit **ON ANY LOT GREATER THAN ONE ACRE** that has an attached garage may be permitted to have a second garage detached from the dwelling unit provided the total floor area of the two garages does not exceed 880 square feet.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls, Ohio. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
