

ORDINANCE NO. 62-2020

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF AGING IN THE SUM OF \$25,000.00 FOR FUNDING FOR JENKINS PLACE SENIOR CENTER AND AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING THE MAYOR'S EXECUTION OF SAID AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio Department of Aging has received Coronavirus Relief Funds pursuant to the CARES Act, a portion of which it has chosen to allocate to senior centers; and

WHEREAS, the city of Olmsted Falls submitted an email application request on or about October 30, 2020, for funding to purchase an Electro Static Sprayer; motion activated light switches and installation; 10 iPads; 1 HP ProBook laptop; 3 Amazon Echo Dots; sound bar for virtual instruction; 17 gift cards to be distributed to Olmsted Falls seniors; and

WHEREAS, on or about December 1, 2020 the City received an award letter granting the above request on the condition that all projects be completed by December 30, 2020; Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council adopts and ratifies the submittal of an application to Cuyahoga County, for reimbursement funding to purchase an Electro Static Sprayer (\$540.00); motion activated light switches and installation (\$660.00); 10 iPads (\$4,028.70); 1 HP ProBook laptop (\$1,373.04); 3 Amazon Echo Dots (\$123.09); sound bar for virtual instruction (\$147.13); 17 gift cards to be distributed to Olmsted Falls seniors (\$6,800.00) and authorizes and ratifies the Mayor's execution of the Agreement, copy of said agreement is attached as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the further reason that submittal, signatures and documentation for reimbursement needs to be received by the County no later than December 30, 2020, and time was of essence.
