

ORDINANCE NO. 21-2022

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR JAMES GRAVEN

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDED CONSULTING AGREEMENT WITH T. JORDAN AND ASSOCIATES, LLC FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Thomas Jordan possesses various skill, experience and expertise in the field of economic development, communications and public relations to serve the city; and

WHEREAS, the Consultant and the City desire to amend the Consulting Agreement adopted by City Council by Ordinance 49-2019 (AMENDED) on June 25, 2019 between the Consultant and the City (the “Original Agreement”) to increase the compensation of the Consultant, the Original Consulting Agreement is hereby; and

WHEREAS, the Administration believes that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into a Consulting Agreement, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, with T. Jordan & Associates, LLC for professional services to the City of Olmsted Falls with respect to economic development; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to compensate Thomas Jordan at a rate of Two Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,200.00) per month for a 12 month initial period (April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023), for 25 hours per month, any additional excess hours will be paid at the rate of \$100.00 per hour. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Consulting Agreement, with T. Jordan & Associates, LLC, in the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof, for professional services to the City of Olmsted Falls with respect to economic development.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the reason that the economic development services provided herein

are needed for the current operation of the City government and, therefore, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
