

RESOLUTION NO. 22-2022

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR JAMES P. GRAVEN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH BROWNING-FERRIS INDUSTRIES OF OHIO, INC., TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL BULK AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES TO THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Browning-Ferris Industries of Ohio, Inc., has previously been contracted to provide trash collection and disposal services in the City of Olmsted Falls through December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this Council determines to authorize the Mayor to enter into a Contract Amendment to provide additional bulk and yard waste services, a copy of said Amendment being attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a Contract Amendment with Browning-Ferris Industries, Inc., 40195 Butternut Ridge Road, Elyria, Ohio 44035, to provide additional bulk and yard waste collection and disposal services to the City.

SECTION 2. The terms and conditions of the Contract Modification Agreement shall begin on May 1, 2022.

SECTION 3. This Council further determines that the remaining services as provided in said contract signed on January 1, 2019, shall remain in full force ending December 31, 2023.

SECTION 4. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Olmsted Falls for the reason that the subject amendment is to begin on May 1, 2022. It shall therefore take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
