

RESOLUTION NO. 23-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF BODY CAMERAS, IN CAR VIDEO SYSTEM, AND ASSOCIATED SOFTWARE AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has determined to purchase six (6) body-worn cameras; two (2) in car video systems and associated software, equipment, and iCloud storage for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, said items are proprietary items and must be compatible with the existing Police Department computer equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department solicited a proposal from Motorola Solutions for said purchase; and

WHEREAS, after review of said proposal, it is the recommendation of the Police Department that a contract for the purchase of six (6) body-worn cameras; two (2) in car video systems and associated software, equipment, and iCloud storage for the Police Department be awarded to Motorola Solutions in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$65,385.00); and

WHEREAS, the initial payment for said purchase will be Fourteen Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Three Dollars (\$14,393.00) with remaining amount paid in annual installments of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$12,748.00) for four years. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. This Council determines that the purchase of six (6) body-worn cameras; two (2) in car video systems and associated software, equipment, and iCloud storage is a necessary and proper expense in the efficient operation of the Police Department.

SECTION 2. This Council determines that such equipment is proprietary items in that must be compatible with the existing computer system in the Police Department.

SECTION 3. The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Motorola Solutions in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$65,385.00), made in annual installments, for such purchase, based generally on the proposal submitted by Motorola Solutions.
