

ORDINANCE NO. 44-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMMUNITY COST-SHARE ACCOUNT OF THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT (NEORS) IN THE SUM OF \$22,162.07 FOR THE METROPOLITAN-HOLTON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORS) maintains a Community Cost-Share Program which provides funding for use in construction operation and maintenance of storm water systems for member communities of which Olmsted Falls is a member; and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Ordinance 11-2020 on January 28, 2020 and entered into a Community Cost-Share Agreement with NEORS on March 5, 2020 for the City's Metropolitan Holton Drainage Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the final design of the storm sewer system was revised to allow an increase in stormwater capacity and include additional catch basins and storm sewer connections; and

WHEREAS, it is, necessary for the parties to amend said Agreement to increase the funding to the City of Olmsted Falls by Twenty-Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and 07/100 (\$22,162.07). Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council adopts the amendment to the NEORS Community Cost Share Program for additional funding to Olmsted Falls in the sum of Twenty Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and 07/100 (\$22,162.07) for the Metropolitan-Holton Drainage Improvement Project, and authorizing the mayor to execute the Agreement, copy of said agreement is attached as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the further reason that NEORS requires the amendment be signed prior to additional funding being sent and time is of the essence for legislative approval
