

RESOLUTION NO. 09-2023

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor James Graven & Council as a Whole

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) FOR AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTER'S GRANT FOR 2022, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPTING SUCH GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has been advised by FEMA through their Assistance to Firefighter's Grant Program that it is eligible to participate in a competitive application process; and

WHEREAS, the city of Olmsted Falls submitted an email application request on or about February 10, 2023, for funding to purchase a Unimac Washer and Dryer in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars (\$15,262.00), requiring a city's participation of 5% of the cost in the sum of Seven Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars and 10/100 (\$763.10). Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council adopts and ratifies the submittal of an application to FEMA, in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars (\$15,262.00) from FEMA Assistance to Firefighter's Grant Program, to be used for the purchase of a Unimac Washer and Dryer, requiring a city's participation of 5% of the cost in the sum of Seven Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars and 10/100 (\$763.10), consistent with the terms of said grant application.

SECTION 2. That the Finance Director shall receive and account for said grant funds and shall administer said funds in compliance with the terms of the grant application and the laws of the State of Ohio and Ordinances of the City.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Olmsted Falls. for the further reason that the grant submittal deadline was on February 10, 2023. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
