

**ORDINANCE NO. 11-2023**

**INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR JAMES P. GRAVEN**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY DISPATCH FOR MOTOROLA COMPUTER ASSISTED DISPATCH SOFTWARE PROGRAM (CAD), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Chagrin Valley Dispatch is purchasing and have available or will have available a CAD software program from Motorola; and

**WHEREAS**, the cities of Strongsville, Berea, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, North Royalton, Olmsted Falls, and Olmsted Township, all collectively hereinafter (“Agencies”) are current members of the Southwest Emergency Dispatch Center hosted by the City of Strongsville and are desirous of using said Motorola CAD software for their purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, all agencies to the Intergovernmental Agreement will benefit by taking advantage of the pricing available to the Chagrin Valley Dispatch Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Chagrin Valley Dispatch is willing to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Agencies to provide them with Motorola CAD software for their use in the Southwest Emergency Dispatch Center, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit “A.” Now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Chagrin Valley for Motorola CAD software for use in the Southwest Emergency Dispatch Center at a total cost to the City of Olmsted Falls of One Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Three Dollars (\$142,343.00) paid in ten annual installments of Fourteen Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars and 30/100 (\$14,234.30), in accordance with the terms and conditions set for in Exhibit “A.”

**SECTION 2.** That the funds necessary to comply with the terms of said agreement are hereby appropriated from the general fund bearing Fund No. 010 for accounts purposes, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay such amounts pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement, attached as Exhibit “A.”

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all

statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the reason that the Chagrin Valley Dispatch Council requires that their Agreements with the Agencies be finalized before the end of January 2023, and therefore, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
