

ORDINANCE NO. 12-2023

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR JAMES P. GRAVEN

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE CITY'S INTENT TO SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY DEEMED TO BE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE OR FOUND OBSOLETE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED BY INTERNET AUCTION UTILIZING GOVDEALS.COM

WHEREAS, the City occasionally has the need to dispose of obsolete equipment that is no longer needed for public or municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, GOVDEALS.com has become a standard mode for many municipalities and has proven to be an effective and reasonable way for municipalities to dispose of obsolete city equipment no longer needed for public or municipal purposes. Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to ORC §721.15 Council hereby demonstrates its intent to utilize internet auction for the disposal of personal property no longer needed for public use, or deemed obsolete or unfit for the purpose in which it was acquired in the manner established by the agreement with GovDeals, Inc., adopted November 8, 2011 by Resolution 117-2011 and which automatically renews annually.

SECTION 2. That the City Council, pursuant to O.R.C. §721.15(C) not only intends to annually adopt the intent to sell such personal property but also will publish in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, subsequent to the adoption of this resolution, a summary notice of this Resolution for two (2) weeks, the second notice to be published not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days after the first notice. Further, the City will post a notice in the offices of the Clerk and Council and the City of Olmsted Falls website continually throughout the year.

SECTION 3. All prior legislation inconsistent with this legislation in whole or in part are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to avoid conflict with this legislation.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
