

RESOLUTION NO. 14-2023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FLOCK SAFETY FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) FALCON LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION CAMERAS AND RELATED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the municipality best interest to purchase three (3) Falcon license plate recognition cameras through Falcon Safety; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the safety director and chief of police that three (3) Falcon license plate recognition cameras and professional services be purchased in an amount not to exceed Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars and 50/100 (\$9,997.50), according to the agreement marked as Exhibit "A" attached; and

WHEREAS, annual maintenance costs for the second year will be Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00), with annual maintenance costs thereafter. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the purchase of three (3) Falcon license plate recognition cameras along with professional services from Falcon Safety for the amount, as identified on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That the funds necessary to acquire the aforesaid cameras are hereby appropriated for the same from Fund No. 146 and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay out such funds as called for hereinabove.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure so that a contract may be entered into without delay in order to continue with the effective operations of the City for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Olmsted Falls for the further reason that the purchase authorized herein is necessary to improve public safety to the municipality and shall take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
