

RESOLUTION NO. 22-2023

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN A GRANT THROUGH THE OHIO BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT FOR ELIGIBLE WORKERS PERFORMING ESSENTIAL WORK THROUGH THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND ACCEPTING SAID FUNDS IF AWARDED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Olmsted Falls desires to participate in the Ohio Ambulance Transportation Program, through the Ohio Office of Budget and Management, for the submission of an application for fire department first responder personnel in relation to H.B. 45; and

WHEREAS, the State, through Office and Budget and Management was directly allocated and accepted \$5.3 billion in Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olmsted Falls is eligible to receive \$20,000 to provide premium pay to eligible workers, with the agreement attached hereto and marked Exhibit “A”; and

WHEREAS, City Council deems it in the best interest of the City to approve said submission of the aforesaid application. Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to take all necessary steps to submit said application to the Ohio Ambulance Transportation Program, through the Office of Budget and Management, and to accept said funds, if awarded, on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the further reason that the deadline for submittals is June 22, 2023. Therefore,
