

RESOLUTION 41-2023

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor James P. Graven and Council as a Whole

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023, ACCEPTING SAID GRANT IF AWARDED, REQUESTING THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT PERMISSION TO PARTICIPATE IN A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Olmsted Falls desires to participate in the 2024 fiscal year Community Development Supplemental Grant Program administered by Cuyahoga County Department of Development; and

WHEREAS, a grant application from the city must be authorized by Council and submitted by the city administration; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize this grant application. Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application to participate in fiscal year 2023 grant funding from the Community Development Supplemental Grant Program, and, if awarded, to accept such grant on behalf of the city, all to assist with the funding of the Police Community Relations Vehicle.

SECTION 2. The City of Olmsted Falls hereby requests that the Cuyahoga County Department of Development accept said Grant Application in the amount of \$50,000 from the city to assist with the funding of the proposed Police Community Relations Vehicle.

SECTION 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to attach a copy of this Resolution to the Application for Assistance.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls, Ohio for the further reason that the application authorized herein must be received by the Cuyahoga County Community Development Department prior to its filing deadline. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
