

ORDINANCE NO. 55-2023

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR JAMES GRAVEN

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, TO ENTER INTO A CONSULTING AGREEMENT WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY ENGINEERING FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO ZONING ADMINISTRATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in accordance with Part 12 – Planning and Zoning Code, Section 1206.02, Administrative Powers and Duties the Mayor desires to confirm the appointment of Mitch Heath from Chagrin Valley Engineering as the Zoning Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the City has an existing contract with Chagrin Valley Engineering and names Mitch Heath who is a licensed engineer and has expertise in the field of zoning administration to serve the City, or his designee in his absence; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to compensate Chagrin Valley Engineering for Zoning Administration at a rate previously approved through Ordinance 54-2023; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Heath will perform zoning administrative duties, when necessary, as directed by the Service Director for the City. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The appointment of Chagrin Valley Engineering will be effective January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2025.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the reason that the services provided herein are needed for the current operation of the City government and, therefore, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
