

RESOLUTION NO. 17-2024

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR JAMES P. GRAVEN AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER CERTIFY CERTAIN TAX VALUATION INFORMATION TO THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03 provides that when a taxing authority determines that it is necessary to levy a tax outside of the ten mill limitation for any purposed authorized by the Revised Code, prior to the certification to the proper county board of elections of its resolution to submit the question of levying a tax outside of the ten mill limitation to the electors of the subdivision, the taxing authority shall certify a resolution to the county auditor requesting that the county auditor certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the subdivision, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills. Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the City of Olmsted Falls.

SECTION 2. The renewal levy rate shall be 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, same as the current rate. Said renewal levy rate shall be levied upon the entire territory of the City, which is located in County of Cuyahoga, for a period of five years, commencing in tax year 2025, first collection in calendar year 2026. The question of the renewal of said levy shall appear on the ballot of November 5, 2024 election. The ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory of the City, and held at the regular place of voting in said City established by the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections or otherwise, within the time provided by law and shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law. That the purpose of this levy is for making appropriations for hospitalization in, and support of, Southwest General Health Center, said renewal tax levy being authorized pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 749.01 and 5705.191.

SECTION 3. That the question of such renewal tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of said City at the general election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

SECTION 4. That this Council hereby requests that the county auditor certify to the City of Olmsted Falls the total current tax valuation of the City of Olmsted Falls and the dollar amount of revenue that will be generated by the one (1) mill renewal tax levy.

SECTION 5. That the Clerk of this Council be and is hereby authorized and directed to certify this resolution to the county auditor of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, requesting that the county auditor certify to the City of Olmsted Falls the total current tax
