

RESOLUTION NO. 21-2024

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS TO PARTICIPATE IN A FIREHOUSE SUBS PUBLIC SAFETY FOUNDATION GRANT, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FIREFIGHTING SUPPLIES AND ACCEPTING SAID FUNDS IF AWARDED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Olmsted Falls desires to participate in the 2024 fiscal year Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation Grant, for the purchase of (1) Genesis E-Force SLI Battery Powered C240 Cutter w/Milwaukee M18 8ah battery (17,895.00); (1) Genesis E-Force SLI Battery Powered S49 Spreader w/Milwaukee M188ah Battery (18,195.00); and (1) Genesis E-Force SL-1 17C Battery Powered Combination Tool (\$18,800.00), in an amount of Fifty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$54,890.00); and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the grant requires a city’s participation cost in the sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$4,890.00). Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The application to the 2024 fiscal year Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation Grant, submission deadline of April 4, 2024, is hereby ratified and the Mayor is authorized to accept said funds, if awarded, on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the reason that the application authorized herein must be submitted by April 4, 2024. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
