

RESOLUTION NO. 28-2024

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN A GRANT THROUGH THE U.S. TREASURY FOR CLAIMS SUBMITTED TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID DURING 2023, AND ACCEPTING SAID FUNDS IF AWARDED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Olmsted Falls desires to participate in the Ohio Ambulance Impacted Industry Program, through the U.S. Treasury, for the submission of an application for claims submitted to the Ohio Department of Medicaid during 2023 in relation to Section 280.10 of H.B. 45; and

WHEREAS, the funding for said program is provided from the state's allocation of Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds from the U.S. Treasury; and

WHEREAS, City Council deems it in the best interest of the City to approve said submission of the aforesaid application. Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The application for the Ohio Ambulance Impacted Industry Program, submitted, May 22, 2024, is hereby ratified and the Mayor is authorized to accept said funds, if awarded, in accordance with the terms of the grant program on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the further reason that the deadline for submittals was May 22, 2024.
