

ORDINANCE NO. 48-2024

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR JAMES GRAVEN AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH STAFFING HR FOR PROFESSIONAL FRACTIONAL HR STAFFING RELATED TO HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, HR Staffing possesses experience and expertise in the field of Human Resources management to serve the City; and

WHEREAS, the Administration believes that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into a Fractional HR Service Agreement, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” with Staffing HR for professional services to the City of Olmsted Falls; and

WHEREAS, the Staffing HR consultant will not be a direct employee or independent contractor for the City of Olmsted Falls; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to compensate Staffing HR at a rate of Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) per hour for services as outlined in Exhibit “A.” Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement, with HR Staffing in the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof, for professional services to the City of Olmsted Falls.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the reason that the services provided herein are needed for the

current operation of the City government and, therefore, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
