****POLK COUNTY TRANSFER STATION MOBILE RECYCLING UNIT GUIDELINES****

Our Mobile Recycling Service will operate all days as scheduled with the following exceptions: *New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.* The mobile unit will not operate on any day that school is cancelled because of inclement weather. We urge all persons not to leave anything at any of our mobile unit sights unless the recycling unit is present. Any dumpsters located at any of our sights *other* than the Polk County Transfer Station are private and are not for use by the public.

ALL RECYCLING MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

All Recycling **Must** Be Removed From Bags and Be Relatively Clean.
All products should be removed from containers prior to recycling.

NO - Plastic Bags

NO - Planting Pots

NO - Styrofoam

NO - PVC

NO - 5 Gallon Buckets

NO - Paint Buckets

NO - Wax Paper

NO - Plastic Toys

NO - Glass

(Exception- Food or Drink Containers)

YES - Food, Beverage, or Household Containers Cans
(Steel, Tin & Aluminum – Separate please)

YES - Food, Beverage, or Household Containers
(Plastic)

YES - Food, Beverage, or Household Containers
(Paper)

YES - Magazines

YES - Cardboard (PLEASE, break *all* boxes down)

YES - Junk Mail

YES - Newspapers

YES - Books

YES - Household Oil

YES - Metal

PLEASE NOTE: Plastics such as, antifreeze and automotive oil containers, pesticide and herbicide containers are '***NOT***' recyclable.

Please ask a 'recycling attendant' for help if you have any questions.
