

POLK COUNTY TRANSFER STATION GUIDELINES

Polk County Residences have several options for the disposal of household waste

For those wishing to haul their own garbage

Polk County Solid Waste Transfer Station Options:

- ❖ \$10.00 - Per Trip Fee – Each trip to the PCSW Transfer Station
- ❖ \$80.00 - Yearly Permit Fee – No limit on trips to the PCSW Station

****PAYMENT TYPES ACCEPTED – CASH & CHECK****

(NO CREDIT OR DEBIT)

Our 'YEARLY PERMITS' and 'PER TRIP FEES' INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING STIPULATIONS:

1. Intended for the dumping of waste from one residence only – NOT FOR COMMERCIAL PURCHASE OR USE
2. May not be used for dumping of quantities GREATER than 300lbs for the following:
 - Yard wasteland
 - Clearing debris
 - Household garbage
 - Furniture

****Loads in excess of 300lbs are weighed and charged by the ton for the entire load****

3. Construction waste - weighed and charged by the ton*** as of July 1, 2021***
4. May not be used for ANY commercial activity.
5. It may NOT be purchased or used for waste resulting from ANY multi-family dwelling, such as a trailer park, rest home, apartment complex, communal living facility or camp ground, etc.
6. Yearly Permit Sticker – Purchaser must place sticker onto the front of a vehicle at the time of purchase or to a location *visible* to the scale attendant.
Another vehicle *may* be used for dumping, by a permit holder by presenting the receipt of purchase to the Scale Attendant.
7. A permit may not be purchased by anyone not residing in Polk County.
8. **EFFECTIVE - 'JULY 1, 2016'**
 - **Computers and other household electronics - \$10.00 PER ITEM**
 - **Clean (unpainted) Block, brick, concrete, asphalt and uncontaminated dirt - \$20.00 PER TON**

POLK COUNTY RESIDENTS ONLY

\$35.00 AVAILABILITY FEE

Included with each *annual property tax bill* is a \$35 solid waste availability fee.

This fee is assigned to each improved property.

Payment of this fee provides the disposal of the following items at no *additional charge*.

- ❖ Food and Beverage Containers
- ❖ Mixed paper – Newspapers - Junk Mail - Books and Magazines
- ❖ Cardboard
- ❖ Waste Oil (household quantities)
- ❖ Scrap Tires
- ❖ Metal
- ❖ Appliances
- ❖ All Batteries - including automotive batteries
- ❖ Furniture - household quantities (less than 300lbs per load)
- ❖ Yard Waste (less than 300lbs per load)
- ❖ Paint (household quantities – maximum - 3 gallons per trip)
- ❖ Antifreeze (household quantities)
- ❖ Cell Phones, printer cartridges
- ❖ Fluorescent bulbs
