- 2-3 Dry erase marker (Write name on this)
- 2-3 Yellow skinny highlighters
- 2 regular size cans of playdoh (play doh brand)
- Headphones (not earbuds) - that we can keep in lockers
- Gym shoes to keep in locker
- Seasonal change of clothes (to be stored in student's locker please label all items with student's name)
