These improvements are designed to modernize access control, enhance emergency response systems, and promote consistent safety standards across all buildings.

Secure Entries and Access Control

Construction of new secure vestibules and installation of modern doors, hardware, and electronic access systems will create monitored and controlled access points while supporting standard operating procedures.

Emergency Readiness and Monitoring

Upgraded surveillance and alarm systems, along with new emergency generators and fire alarms, will enhance real-time monitoring and response times and will help critical systems remain operational during power outages and emergencies.
