ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

To guarantee that all students have been accounted for and have arrived safely at the school, parents are asked to call in to report the absence of their child each morning before 9:00 A.M. (early start) or 10:00 A.M. (late start). The school will call to check on any unconfirmed absences. If a parent/guardian cannot be reached, a message will be left. If the parent/guardian does not contact the School Office within 72 hours, the absence will be marked as Unexcused. Calls can be received 24 hours a day and on weekends.
