

Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA)

Two to three times a year, students in grades K-5 are given the DRA. Assessments are given in the fall and once or twice later in the year to determine growth. Teachers administer the DRA one-on-one with students. The assessment includes an opportunity for students to read aloud a portion of a text and answer questions about what they have read. This assessment gives teachers detailed information about a student's reading level and helps them identify areas for targeted instruction.
