Important information to know:

- For yearlong courses earning high school credit, both semesters will be assessed at the same time in one assessment during the June testing out window.
- A student must pass (earn 78% or better) in order to earn credit and in the case of a sequence of courses, to enroll in the next course.
- All middle school students who successfully test out and aim to take a course at one of our high schools will be
 attend that course at South Lyon High School, regardless of where their residence falls in respect to the high
 school boundaries. SLHS is closer to both middle schools and therefore less instructional time is lost due to
 travel.
- The student remains a middle school student despite the coursework being taken at SLHS. The student is not eligible to participate in high school extracurricular activities or events as a high school student.
- Middle school students approved to take a course at SLHS will be bussed there in the mornings. A bus is
 provided at the end of first hour at SLHS to the middle schools.
- This arrangement does <u>not</u> grant a middle school student living within the East High School boundaries the right
 to continue at SLHS once they become a high school student. Students will enter their freshman year at their
 boundary-determined high school.
- Due to scheduling constraints, the only courses guaranteed to be offered during first hour at SLHS are:
 - Algebra II
 - Pre-Calculus
 - Spanish II

For all other courses, if a first hour is not available, students may defer for a year or enroll in an equivalent 21f course.
