On motion by Commissioner Fee and seconded by Commissioner Kelley it was ordered that the following Finance and Administration Committee report be approved:

Finance and Administration Committee Minutes of the January 4, 2021 Meeting

Members of the Finance and Administration Committee met in regular session on Monday, January 4, 2021, at the County Administration Offices at 4:00 p.m.

Members present were Commissioners Adams, Barlow, Copeland, Fee, Naifeh, Smith, Sneed, and Turner. Commissioner Mason was absent. County Executive Jeff Huffman, Peggy Murdock, TCS Finance Director, Boyd Hendrix, County IT Director, Robin Sealy, Workforce Development Director, and Nancy Huelsing, Assistant to the County Executive, were also present.

Chair lady Fee brought the meeting to order and declared a quorum. Congratulations were offered to Commissioner Mason on his recent wedding.

Commissioner Naifeh opened the meeting in prayer.

Ms. Peggy Murdock presented amendments for the General Purpose School Fund 141. These amendments addressed two grants received, one totally \$39,967 for STEM programs in middle schools, and the other totaling \$976,742, from the USDA for equipment. The motion was made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Turner that the amendments in Fund 141 be approved. Motion passed with none opposing.

Ms. Murdock then presented amendments for Fund 142, School Federal Projects. These amendments were in the Special Education Program and totaled \$41,000. The motion was made by Commissioner Barlow and seconded by Commissioner Naifeh to approve the amendments as presented in Fund 142. The motion passed with none opposing.

County Executive Huffman informed the Committee that only one bid was received for the EMA tower. That bid was from Integrated Communications, Inc. for \$61,677.15. The motion was made by Commissioner Sneed and seconded by Commissioner Naifeh to award the bid to Integrated Communications, Inc. The motion passed with none opposing.

County Executive Huffman then presented bids from two companies for HVAC equipment for the Depot Building. Bids were submitted by BR Supply and Southern Integrated Services Inc. The motion was made by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Sneed to accept the bid from BR Supply for \$14,329.07 for the units plus duct and accessories. The motion passed with none opposing.

County Executive Huffman then presented to the Committee the various fee structures in Circuit Court and General Sessions, asking if the Committee felt that the fees needed review in light of the revenue generated. Although no action was taken on the matter, the Committee agreed a closer look at court fees is warranted.

The motion was made by Commissioner Copeland and seconded by Commissioner Turner to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 5:15 p.m.


Chairman Bob Wilson called the meeting to order and established that a quorum was present.

IN RE: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COUNTY EXECUTIVE JEFF HUFFMAN TO APPLY FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS FOR FIRE PROTECTION PROJECT

On motion by Commissioner Sneed and seconded by Commissioner Copeland it was ordered that the following Resolution authorizing County Executive Jeff Huffman to apply for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for Fire Protection Project be approved:

RESOLUTION No 21/01/416

TIPTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Community Development Block Grant Program has been established to assist local governments in meeting community development and housing needs consistent with the objectives as set forth in Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Tipton County acting by and through its County Commission proposes to apply for 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the purpose of performing eligible community development activities that will benefit residents in Tipton County.

WHEREAS, Tipton County will provide local financial support in conjunction with the CDBG funds to complete the above project(s); and

WHEREAS, under the terms and provisions of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, Tipton County as a recipient is required to designate and appoint a Financial Officer to perform certain duties in the administration of said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commission of Tipton County as follows:

THAT, Jeff Huffman, County Executive, is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Tennessee, Department of Economic and Community Development, Office of Program Management, requesting Fiscal Year 2021 Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount not to exceed \$400,000, plus any eligible Three-Star bonus allowance, for a Fire Protection Project; and

THAT, Tipton County will be responsible for the local cash/match to be provided in full by the general account; and

THAT, Jeff Huffman, County Executive, be and is hereby designated and appointed as Financial Officer under the terms and pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and to perform on behalf of Tipton County, Tennessee, those acts and assume such duties as are consistent with said position.
