A motion was made by Commissioner Adkins and seconded by Commissioner Wooten to set the speed limit on Tippy Dr at 25 mph.

A motion was made by Commissioner Murphy and seconded by Commissioner Shopher to set the speed limit on Trotter Rd at 35 mph.
