

TIPTON COUNTY LANDFILL RULES AND REGULATIONS

AUTHORITY

The Rules and Regulations are adopted, and may be amended, by Tipton County Public Works.

USE OF THE FACILITY

The use of the Tipton County Landfill Facility, by any person, is a privilege and shall be at the direction of the attendant in charge. No person using the Facility shall violate any directive put forth by the attendant. If any person refuses to follow a directive of the attendant, the attendant shall have the authority to immediately refuse that person access to the Facility. The attendant(s) may examine any material brought to the Facility to ensure compliance with the Rules and Regulations. Wastes will be deposited in areas as designated by signs on site, or as directed by attendants.

PERMITS

The Tipton County Landfill and Recycling Facility is operated for the benefit of the Tipton County Residents and Commercial Businesses. Admission to the facility will be by current fiscal year annual permit, day pass, or commercial fee/punch card only, unless for recycling purposes. Only waste collected within Tipton County is allowed to be deposited at the Tipton County Landfill and Recycling Facility. Failure to comply will result in revocation or suspension of permit to use the facility.

LANDFILL RULES

DO: Be courteous and patient; Be alert; Drive 10 MPH; Properly cover or tarp your load; Keep children and pets secured inside vehicle; Ask where to place items; Follow attendant's directions; Prepare to be outside of the Landfill exit gate before closing time.

DO NOT: Argue with attendants; Speed; Block roads or entrance; Give or sell items to other patrons or employees; Scavenge or remove items from property; Climb on or over rails into bins; Loiter; Swear. DO NOT: Dump any liquids, closed containers or barrels, hot ashes or burning materials, or dead animals.

The Director of Operations reserves the right to revoke any permit and/or permanently ban rule violators.

The Landfill and Convenience Center cannot accept Hazardous Waste of any kind. (Paint, gas, propane, kerosene, household cleaners, lawn chemicals, auto cleaning products, etc.) Tipton County Clean Community hosts a Hazardous Waste Pickup Location twice a year. FEES

CASH, CHECKS, AND CREDIT CARDS (ADDED FEE) ARE ACCEPTED.

\$35.00 - Annual Permit for July 1- June 30th

\$5.00 - One Day Pass

\$10.00 - Replacement Permit

\$7.00 - Per Yard Commercial Use

RESIDENTIAL - Permits will only be sold to Tipton County Residents with **TWO** proofs of household address, such as: current Utility bills; Driver's license; Voter's registration; Vehicle registration; Property tax; Lease; Fishing/Hunting License, etc. **Sharing/swapping permits from one household to another is unlawful and strictly forbidden. Anyone using a permit without proper proof of residence for that permit is subject to having that permit revoked. Random checks will be done.**

COMMERCIAL BUSINESSES - A \$7.00 per yard Commercial tipping fee will be charged for a Tipton County business or any business performing work on a Tipton County Resident's property with written proof of customer address. Tipton County businesses may set up a billing account with the Public Works Office by providing proof of a Tipton County business license, or pre-purchase yardage on a Punch Card.

RENTAL PROPERTY OWNERS - Solid waste generated from the operation of a rental property, including cleanouts, is subject to Commercial fees as a business.

TIRE DISPOSAL

\$1.00 Each - Passenger Car Tires

\$5.00 Each - Farm/Ag Tires

\$2.00 Each - Truck and Semi Tires

\$0.50 Each - ATV Tires

Tire fees for Commercial businesses and residents without a permit can be paid at the Tipton County Public Works or Landfill Office. When disposing large quantities of tires, please call the Landfill Office at 901-837-5907 to ensure available space.

TRASH DISPOSAL

All acceptable items must be placed in the designated area or container.

Place loose household trash inside the large roll-off bins in the Convenience Center. Place bagged trash in the roll off bins or in the compactor by the Recycling Center. Place metal items inside one of the roll off bins marked METAL. (See Recycling list.) Place larger items inside the large roll-off bins. (couches, furniture, etc.) Stack mattresses and box springs to the side of the last roll off bin. Dispose of brush and tree limbs, construction & demolition waste (wood, sheet rock, shingles, etc.) and burnouts by following the signs past the roll-off bins to the back of the Landfill Facility. **Insulation and vinyl siding must be placed in roll off bins.**

RECYCLING

The Tipton County Solid Waste Recycling Center will accept the following materials for recycling with no fee or permit required:

REMOVE ALL RECYCLE MATERIALS FROM CONTAINERS OR BAGS.

CARDBOARD BOXES

Clean, dry, flattened cardboard (Corrugated boxes; shoe, beverage, or cereal boxes.)

NEWSPAPERS

Clean, dry newspapers and inserts.

PLASTIC

#1-#2 Plastic Only (Hard plastic- bottle caps, toiletry containers, shampoo bottles, etc.)

No plastic bags of any type. All oil containers are to be placed in bin next to oil.

METAL

Any metal (lawn furniture, large appliances, swing sets, air conditioners, tire rims, clean empty food cans, etc.) No propane bottles, gas tanks, or gas cans of any kind!

ELECTRONICS

Computers, monitors, keyboards, television sets, etc.

ALUMINUM CANS

Empty, dry drink cans.

HIGH GRADE OFFICE PAPER

Computer paper — green bar, very white and shiny

White bond — any white sheet paper: copy paper, register tapes,

laser printed computer paper, bond printouts, envelopes (no windows).

WASTE OIL

The landfill has two large containers in which to dispose used oil (motor, transmission, hydraulic, cooking). Place empty oil containers in bin next to the oil recycle containers.

ANTIFREEZE

The landfill has one large container in which to dispose used antifreeze.

Place empty antifreeze containers in the bin next to the antifreeze recycle container.

BATTERIES

Used batteries may be placed on the designated pallets.

Cardboard, #1-#2 plastics, and newspaper Recycling drop off bins are available in Munford at Haddad's and in Covington by the Water Plant Tower.
