power, and occasionally need transportation, call Erie County Senior Services at 858-7433 (RIDE) for info. Our van runs Tuesday through Friday from 7:30 AM - 2:30 PM. The cost is \$8.00 for a one-way trip and \$16 roundtrip. We work on a basis - medical appointments first, then priority banking & grocery shopping. This service is possible by the City of Tonawanda, made Erie County Department of Senior Services and the NYS Office for the Aging.


