    - N. Heling reported that the Health Department is currently working with 8 Alverno Nursing students. The students will be working on a mini-Community Health Assessment along with working on plans for National Public Health Week. Student Nurses from MSOE will be working with the department starting in March.

  - a. **Health Literacy follow up discussion:** N. Heling tasked the members to bring ideas as to what they would like to see listed on the Greendale Health Department website. The Village website is currently having some updates completed. BOH members can send ideas to N. Heling who will complete the pages. In addition to the website update, there was discussion about participation in Village events over the next year. R. Barbian motioned that the BOH will focus on the website as phase 1 with 2 other phases to follow, expanding to booths at markets. The third phase to be determined at a future date. - b. **Health Officer Report:** N. Heling reviewed the January 2023 report. Highlighted in the report was the Qualitative Data Focus Group, the February Radon event, Vaping presentation to over 600 students at MLHS, 35 community members were trained on administration of Narcan, 3 blood pressure clinics sites with 46 clients.
- c. **Community Health (CHIP) Workgroups Report**
  - i. **Successful Aging in Greendale for Everyone (SAGE):** M. Green facilitates this workgroup. M. Green reported the group is in their next 5-year cycle. They will be conducting a walking audit with AARP and possibly scouts and NHS students. Bill Armbruster from AARP will be coming to Greendale. Plan to return to St. Al's in 2024 for a Community Health Fair, discussed ADRC partnership, along with an upcoming survey.
  - ii. **Healthy Minds, Healthy Greendale:** T. Rypel reported that HMHG planning is underway for Mental Health Month. So far two events are scheduled, Glow Yoga and a Mandala Art Therapy workshop. Look for more details to come.
  - iii. **Step Up to Better Health:** T. Rypel reported that the group is meeting this week. Working on tabling at Family Wellness Event. Also preparing for Community Garden sign up.
  - iv. **Community Alliance:** N. Heling reported that Community Alliance had partnered with Audacy Radio stations, the campaign reached over 330,000 people. Partnered with West Allis community members for Narcan training, Parent information night with scouts, teams working on follow up from the family event.
  - v. **Trustee Report:** R. Barbian shared information from the Board of Trustee meeting.
