New Business

- **CHIP Summit Recap-** Completed a [Time Slips](#) creative story telling activity which promotes creative engagement, designed to bring meaning and purpose into the lives of older adults (dementia) and those who care for them. You look at a picture and as a group describe what's going on to build a story about the photo. Reported out on accomplishments and future goals of each workgroup. Brainstorming time as a table to answer prompts on things we could do to continue to improve public health in Greendale.
- **Presentation of Playground Quest App:** As past participants of Step Up to Better Health's "playground passport" program and now advocates for encouraging physical activity in our community, Greendale High School students and members of Greendale Robotics' Team ALIEN; Cole Bucek, Ava Scheuer, Ari Scheuer, and Evie Skibicki created an original app called "Playground Quest". They submitted their app and associated [promotional video](#) to [the Congressional App Challenge](#) and won first place for their district and will be moving on to the National competition in Washington D.C this spring. The app program allows participants to check in to different playgrounds via a special code vs. geo location (protecting privacy). Once they complete that activity, they can receive an in-app badge. These badges could be used as entries for the annual playground passport program.
- **2023 Annual Report Released-** available in Department documents on Health Department website. An annual report is required by State Statutes. In the Annual Report, **on page 8** there is information and details about Community Health Assessment (CHA) and Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP), which are also required by State Statutes. CHA and CHIP information can also be found on our website
- **Guidelines for Workgroup Collaboration** Focused on 3 areas: participation, communication, group goals. The Board was asked to review the guidelines and bring back any suggestions or ideas they would like to add from a BOH perspective.
