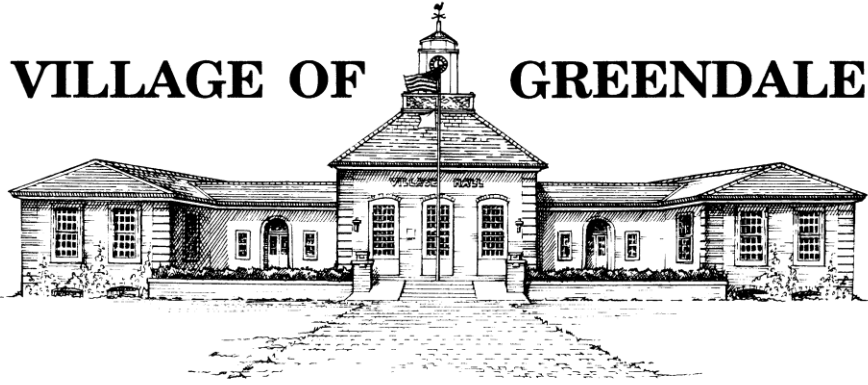

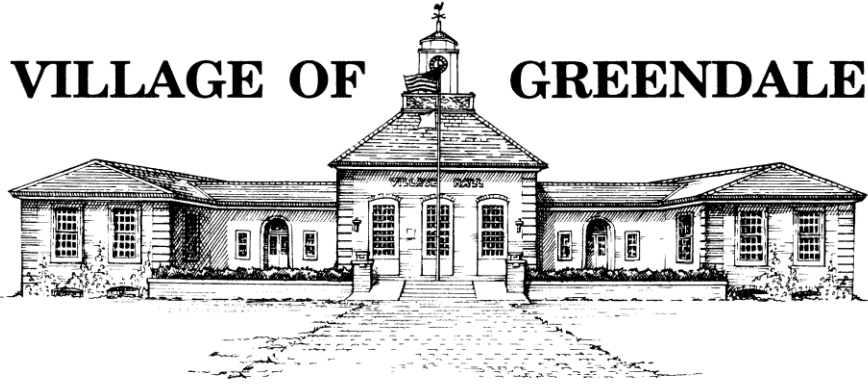

6. **REPORTS:**
 - a. **Medical Advisor Report:** Dr. Siddiqui reported by phone on the COVID-19 situation. He reported that they are seeing COVID-19 in children with a milder form than adults. The biggest challenge is children are contagious, they don't show many symptoms. Viral load determines how infectious. The higher the load, the more symptoms. Dr. Siddiqui also thanked the Greendale Health Department for their important work during this time.
 - b. **Trustee Report:** No Update
 - c. **Health Officer Report:** S. Shepard, Health Officer reviewed the July Board of Health Report. The Health Department continues to implement the continuity of operations plan during the COVID-19 pandemic. This plan has us focus on the COVID-19 response, human health hazards, and resident concerns and complaints.
7. **New Business:**
 - a. Update on health department response to COVID-19 (coronavirus): S. Shepard shared a COVID-19 update report. As of 8/13/2020, there have been 181 confirmed cases of COVID-19 since mid-March, 9 Greendale businesses have had outbreaks, and 3 deaths in residents. The Health Department partnered with the National Guard, Greendale School District, Greendale Police, Fire, and DPW to offer free COVID-19 testing at the Greendale High School on July 31st and August 1st. 800 tests were completed in 10 hours of clinic operation. Next biggest challenge is the return to schools The Greendale Health Department has been part of a planning team to help with school re-opening plans. Plans include how to deal with outbreaks at school, how to handle testing, isolating quickly and quarantine requirements. Our guidance and recommendations that we follow are based on CDC, DHS and DPI recommendations. Health

We partner currently with the Greendale Fire Department and community volunteers on our annual flu clinic and would most likely look to these same groups to assist with a COVID-19 vaccine event. Pilot testing program logistics are being discussed more details as they become available.

- b. Discussion on Racism as a Public Health Crisis started with a short video titled "Let's Learn Public Health. The video explained how public health differs from clinical medicine and showed the depth of analysis and importance of looking beyond a single individual situation. Following the video Zilber School of Public Health student, Kinsey Mannebach presented data and research on Racism as a Public Health Crisis. Members discussed the issue and will review the Village Resolution at the next meeting.
