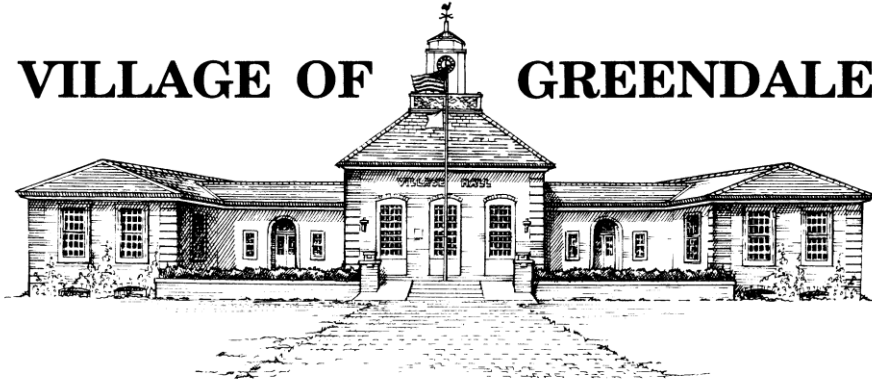

**PLACE:** Greendale Safety Center

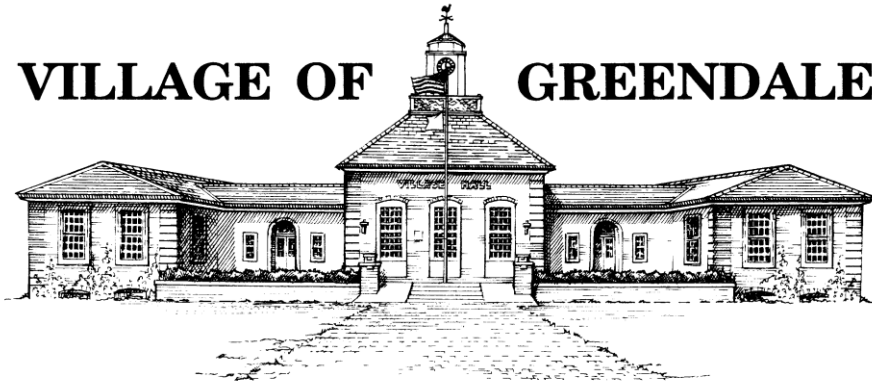

5. **New Business**
  - a. **Welcome to New Board of Health Members!**
    - i. R. Barbian welcomed G. Ouellette to the Greendale BOH. G. Ouellette introduced himself and shared some information on his background and interest in the Greendale BOH.
    - ii. **Presentation of "What is a Local Health Department and What Does it Do?"** A. Haas reviewed a [WALHDAB](#) (Wisconsin Association of Local Health Departments and Boards) Board of Health Orientation PowerPoint (PPT), on the topic of local health departments. A. Haas shared that WALHDAB has many resources and trainings for BOH members. The PPT is available in a few spots on the Greendale Health Department website, including the [BOH portion of the webpage](#). She shared that BOH members might have an interest in getting involved with one of the Community Health Improvement Plan (Community Health Initiatives) workgroups. There are four workgroups: Step Up to Better Health (focus on nutrition and physical activity), Successful Aging in Greendale for Everyone (SAGE), Healthy Minds, Health Greendale (focus on mental health), and Community Alliance (focus on prevention of youth substance misuse).



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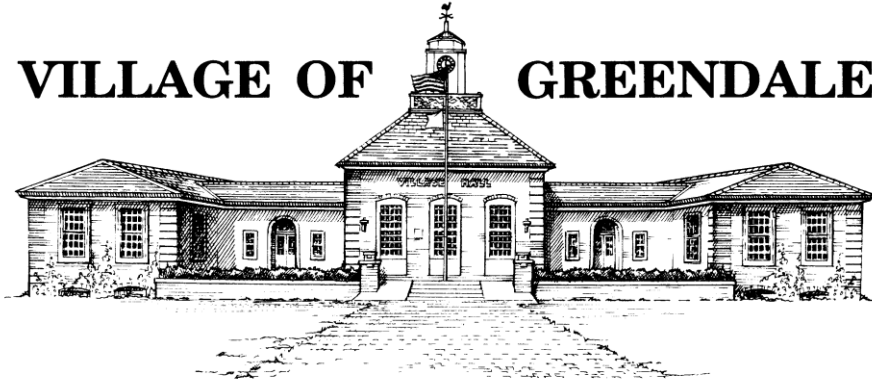

  - a. **Medical Advisor:** A. Siddiqui, MD, no report
  - b. **Health Officer Report:** A. Haas reviewed the August 2022 BOH reports. She highlighted two upcoming events this fall. The Step Up to Better Health Walk/Run on 10/23/22 and the Annual Community Flu Clinic on Tuesday, 10/25/22.
  - c. **Community Health (CHIP) Workgroups Report**
    - i. **Successful Aging in Greendale for Everyone (SAGE):** M. Green facilitates this workgroup. Updates on the five-year community survey, resources for older adults and the AARP Livable Community application. SAGE will share Brain Health education at the PAGE Wellness event on 9/17, the monthly Memory Café meets on 9/28 and the October/November dementia newsletter will go out at the end of the month. R. Barbian shared the remarkable evolution of this committee.
    - ii. **Healthy Minds, Healthy Greendale:** A. Haas shared that there is a monthly steering committee meeting. The group is working on mental health resources that also support Community Alliance. This group will share resources at the PAGE Wellness event, in addition to numerous website resources.
    - iii. **Step Up to Better Health:** T. Rypel reported the workgroup is planning for the annual Fun Run/Walk on October 23<sup>rd</sup>, which is a major school fundraiser. Over a dozen sponsors have committed financially and numerous community members have contributed raffle prizes. Pre-registration deadline is 9/23, participants can register right up until the day of the event.
    - iv. **Community Alliance:** A. Haas shared that the Wake-Up Call bedroom was in the lower level of the library during Village Days. There were Exit Plan and Small Talks resources available for participants. Working on the Narcan Direct Program for distribution in the community.
    - v. **Trustee Report:** R. Barbian shared information from the Board of Trustees meeting on 09/6/2022.
