- Week of 8/1: 54 new cases
- Week of 8/8: 23 new cases
- Week of 8/15: 28 new cases
- Week of 8/22: 31 new cases
 - 8/29 – 8/31: 10 new cases

146 total cases (confirmed and probable) in August

- up from 34 (confirmed) total cases in July and 3 (confirmed) cases in the month of June.

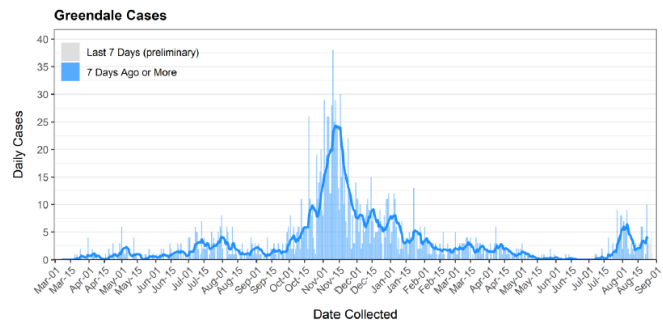
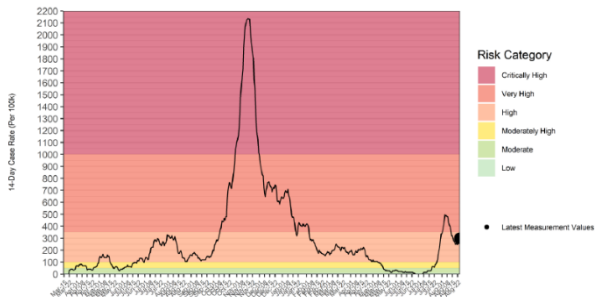
Positivity Rate*

- 7/28 through 8/10/21: 11.7%
- 8/5 through 8/18/21: 7.8%
- 8/11 through 8/24/21: 7.4%
- 8/18 through 8/31/21: 7.3%

*The positivity rate is the percentage of all coronavirus tests performed that are actually positive. The percent positive is a critical measure because it gives us an indication of how widespread infection is in the area where the testing is occurring and whether levels of testing are keeping up with the level of disease transmission.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- Vaccination rates as of 9/2/2021
 - 68% of the **total population** has received at least 1 dose of COVID-19 vaccine
 - 65% of the **total population** is fully vaccinated (1 dose J&J or 2 doses of Pfizer or Moderna + 2 weeks)
 - 82% of Greendale **adults** are fully vaccinated
 - 88% of Greendale adults **65 and up** are fully vaccinated
 - 23% of Greendale **children** under 18 years old are fully vaccinated
 - Note: only 12 and up are currently eligible for vaccination
