### Positivity Rate\*

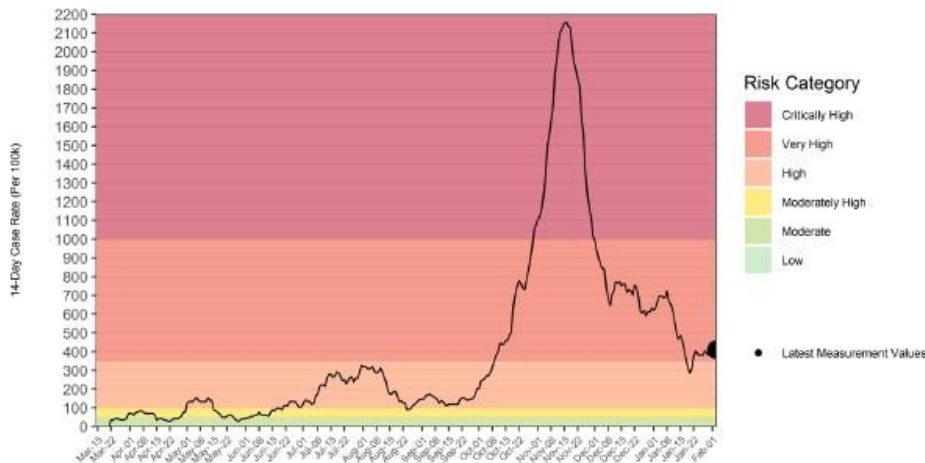
- 12/23/20 through 01/5/21: 14.5%

The positivity rate is the percentage of all coronavirus tests performed that are actually positive. The percent positive is a critical measure because it gives us an indication of how widespread infection is in the area where the testing is occurring and whether levels of testing are keeping us with levels of disease transmission.

### COVID Vaccine

- Greendale Health Department administered the first COVID vaccines on 01/05/2021 to health care providers.
- During the month of January, we administered a total of 606 COVID vaccines to health care providers, law enforcement, and school staff providing medical care to students.
- Beginning on 1/25/2021, we were able to vaccinate older adults 65+ years of age.
