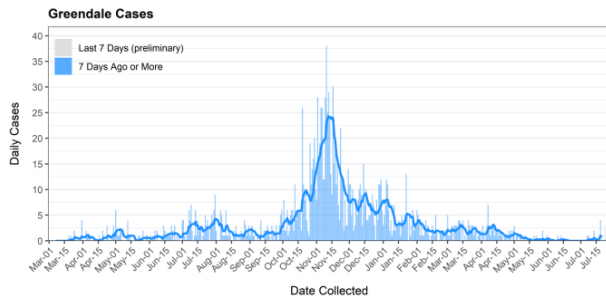
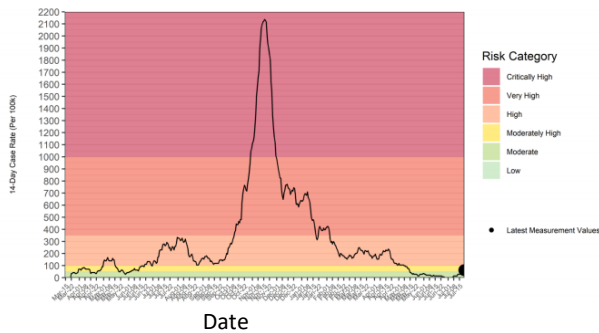
- 6/23/21 through 7/6/21: 0.0%

*the positivity rate is the percentage of all coronavirus tests performed that are actually positive. The percent positive is a critical measure because it gives us an indication of how widespread infection is in the area where the testing is occurring and whether levels of testing are keeping up with the level of disease transmission.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- Vaccination rates as of 7/28/2021
 - **78%** of Greendale adults have received at least 1 dose of COVID-19 vaccine
 - **65%** of the total population in Greendale have received at least 1 dose
 - **75%** of Greendale adults are fully vaccinated (1 dose of Johnson & Johnson or 2 doses of Pfizer or Moderna)
 - **62%** of the total population is fully vaccinated
