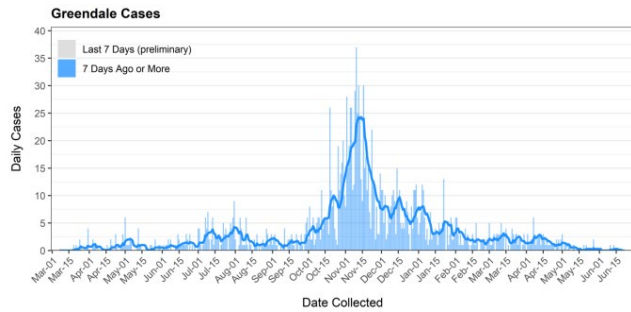
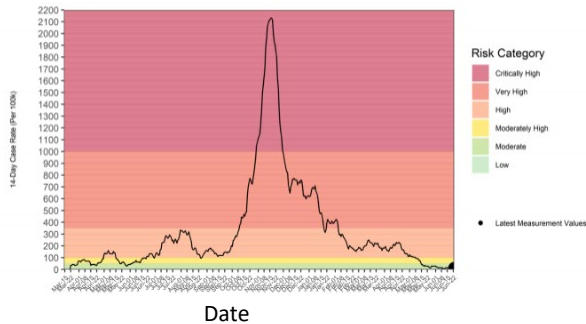

*The positivity rate is the percentage of all coronavirus tests performed that are actually positive. The percent positive is a critical measure because it gives us an indication of how widespread infection is in the area where the testing is occurring and whether levels of testing are keeping up with the level of disease transmission.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- On June 4, Pfizer vaccine emergency use authorization (EUA) was expanded to include 12-15 years old's
 - Partnered with Hayat Pharmacy and Greendale School District to vaccinate students
- Greatly decreased vaccinations due to decline in demand
- As of 7/1, Greendale vaccination rates were:
 - 64% of the total population with at least 1 dose, 61% fully vaccinated
 - 77% of adults with at least 1 dose, 73% fully vaccinated
 - 91% of adults 65 and older with at least 1 dose, 88% fully vaccinated
