Greendale Middle School Investigation

On Monday, November 21, 2022, at approximately 11:17 am, Greendale Police Officers were alerted to a threat made via social media to “shoot up” the Greendale Middle School.

School safety procedures were put into place, and officers remained on scene to maintain security and investigate the threat. Through diligent police work, it was determined that there is not a credible threat to the school. Extensive investigation revealed that the display name used on the social media profile was a fictitious person. The subject who created the fake social media account was identified as a student, and the subject will be referred to the Milwaukee County Children’s Center for charges.

The Greendale Police Department cannot stress strongly enough the importance of talking with your children about the dangers of social media and the serious consequences that may result from making threats against the school. If your child receives a suspicious or threatening message, “say something” by immediately contacting the Greendale Police Department at (414) 423-2121.
