COVID-19 Cases

- 10/1-10/7/21: 37 new cases
- 10/8-10/13/21: 20 new cases
- 10/14-10/21/21: 15 new cases
- 10/21-10/28/21: 22 new cases
- 10/29-11/4/21: 38 new cases

In the month of October, we received notification of 105 total (confirmed and probable) COVID-19 cases. The average age for the month of October was 43 years old. The youngest affected was an infant and the oldest was 92 years old.

*Please note the weekly totals may not line up perfectly with the month total (October 1st-31st) as our weekly data is collected on Thursday evenings.

Positivity Rate

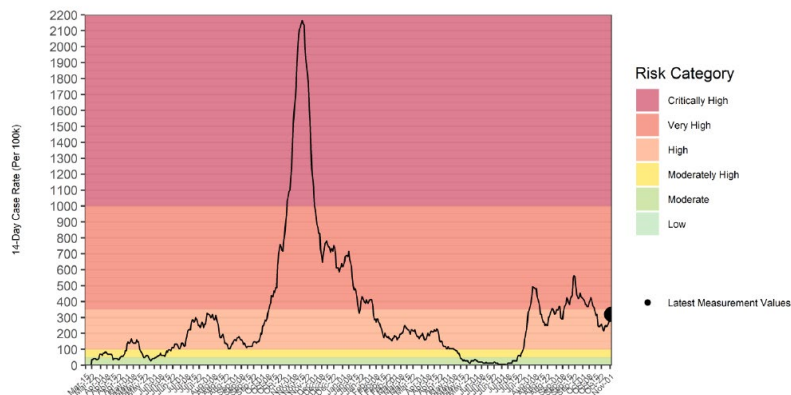
- 9/30-10/13/21: 7.5%
- 10/7-10/20/21: 5%
- 10/14-10/27/21: 5.7%
- 10/21-11/3/21: 7.1%

The positivity rate is the percentage of all coronavirus tests performed that are actually positive. The percent positive is a critical measure because it gives us an indication of how widespread infection is in the area where the testing is occurring and whether levels of testing are keeping us with levels of disease transmission.

COVID Vaccination Rates (10/31/21)

- 71% of the total population has received at least 1 dose of COVID-19 vaccine
- 68% of the total population is fully vaccinated (1 dose of J&J or 2 doses of Pfizer or Moderna)
- 82% of Greendale adults are fully vaccinated
 - 14.7% of Greendale adults have received a booster dose
