1. Call to Order.

2. Upon motion duly made, seconded and approved by a roll call vote of the Commissioners present at the meeting, the Commission reserves the right to adjourn into "Closed Session," pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(f), Wisconsin State Statutes, to consider financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons and the preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data or involved in such problems and Wisconsin State Statutes Section 19.85(1)(c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, specifically to discuss the hiring and promotional processes for specific individuals at the Police Department and the educational requirements for a Captain at the Fire Department.

3. The Commission may return to open session to take action on those matters discussed in closed session.

Starting at 9:00 AM.

4. Hearing seeking review of the Fire Chief's action against Firefighter Jarod Kimber.

5. The Commission may visit the site of the charges.

6. Upon motion duly made, seconded and approved by a roll call vote of the Commissioners present at the meeting, the Commission reserves the right to adjourn into "Closed Session," pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(g), Wisconsin State Statutes, as needed during the hearing to confer with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved, specifically the hearing on the appeal of charges against Firefighter Jarod Kimber.

7. The Commission will return to open session to take action on those matters discussed in closed session and/or continue the hearing on the appeal of charges against Firefighter Jarod Kimber.

8. Upon motion duly made, seconded and approved by a roll call vote of the Commissioners present at the meeting, the Commission reserves the right to adjourn into "Closed Session," pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a), Wisconsin State Statutes, as needed during the hearing to deliberate concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governmental body, specifically the hearing on the appeal of charges against Firefighter Jarod Kimber.

9. The Commission will return to open session to take action on those matters discussed in closed session, continue the hearing and/or deliberate and act on the matter subject to the hearing on the appeal of charges against Firefighter Jarod Kimber.
