

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

The Town of Wenham through its Board of Selectmen will receive sealed Bids for construction of ADA Ramps and Sidewalks until Thursday June 30, 2022 at 11:00 AM local time, at the Office of the Highway Department, Wenham Town Hall 2nd Floor, 138 Main Street, Wenham MA 01984 at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) prequalification is required. Prevailing wage rates are required as per M.G.L., Chapter 149, and Section 26 to 27H inclusive and reporting associated thereto. Estimated project value in Contract Year One is \$60,000, with an option to renew for two additional years with estimated project values of \$40,000 and \$50,000 respectively.

Bidding information may be reviewed at and/or obtained at no charge from the Office of the Highway Department, Wenham Town Hall 2nd Floor, 138 Main Street, Wenham MA 01984 between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:30 PM Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, between the hours of 9:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Tuesday, and between the hours of 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM on Friday after 10:00 AM on Wednesday June 15, 2022. Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond, a certified check, a treasurer's or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company or cash payment, in the amount of five (5) percent of the submitted bid, as Bid Security. The checks are to be made payable to the Town of Wenham, Massachusetts.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Payment and Performance Bond each in the amount of 100% of the Contract amount. No Bidder may withdraw his/her Bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date designated above for the opening.

Bids for this Contract are subject to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 30, Section 39M and M.G.L., Chapter 30B as applicable.

The Town of Wenham reserves the right to reject any or all Bids or to accept any Bid deemed by them to be in the best interest of the Town of Wenham, and to limit the extent of the work to keep within the limits of available funds.
